

Proposed Work Schedule, Week of July 2nd – Brandon NH 019-3 (496) Segment 6

PLEASE NOTE AN INFORMATIONAL MEETING WILL BE HELD ON Wednesday, July 12th at 6:30pm in THE TOWN HALL BASEMENT MEETING ROOM. THIS PUBLIC MEETING IS OPENING TO ANY RESIDENTS OR BUSINESSES THAT WOULD LIKE INFORMATION ON THE WORK OCCURRING THIS YEAR IN SEGMENT B.

PROJECT LOCATION: Segment 6 project limits start south on Route 7 at the Fire Station and ends just north of the Shell Station on Route 7, the project also includes work on portions of Park St, Conant Sq, Rossiter, Union, Carver, and Grove St.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of roadway widening, sidewalks and curbs, pavement markings, traffic signs, signal, water main, sanitary sewer, aerial, & underground utilities and stormwater improvements for the Brandon Village portion of US Route 7 to include a portion of Franklin Street, a portion of Park Street, Center Street, Conant Square, a portion of Carver St, a portion of Rossiter St, and a portion of Grove Street. Preconstruction activities including tree removal, exploratory excavation, temporary construction signage installation, and overhead utility relocation will be occurring over the next six weeks.

PROJECT DURATION: This project will be on going now through November 2019, with work divided in six segments (A thru F). This year's work will be occurring on Segment B, which is Brandon Green Area, on Route 7 from Lake Sunapee Bank to the Brandon Public Library and portion of Carver St, Park, Union, and Rossiter St.

Upcoming work in the next three weeks:

PRECONSTRUCTION SURVEYS: Certified Letter were sent to residents abutting segment B. The General Contractor, Casella Construction, Inc., is utilizing a consultant, Continental Placer, Inc, to perform preconstruction surveys of homes and businesses abutting the work site. Surveys will be completed in July, residents and business are encouraged to respond to the letter.

AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY: Pre-construction aerial photography will be completed by Town utilizing University of Vermont unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) following July 4th. Information notices were delivery to all project abutters on June 28-29th.

CONSTRUCTION SIGNAGE: Temporary Orange Construction Signs will be installed in July.

TREES: Tree removal throughout the project length will commence on July 10th.

TRAFFIC DELAYS: No traffic delays are anticipated for the week of July 2nd, with exception to one lane alternating traffic to facilitate the relocation of overhead utilities from the center of town south towards the Fire Station.
