Open Studio Weekend is a statewide celebration of the visual arts, offering a unique opportunity for visitors to meet local artists in their studios, and purchase high quality artwork. A quilt trail is a series of square boards painted with dynamic quilt block designs. They can be placed on the exterior of barns, homes, and businesses.
