Accomplishments


Corpus Christi School is a Blue Ribbon School of Excellence named by the U.S. Department of Education.

NWEA Grade Level Data




Students in the Catholic Elementary and Middle Schools of the Archdioceses of Hartford, which includes Corpus Christi School, take the NWEA Assessment.

This year, as in previous years, students at Corpus Christi School did extremely well in all subtests: Math, Reading, and Vocabulary.


The bar graph indicates the percent of CCS Students who scored above grade level.

Grade 3 - Grade 7 Comparison




Corpus Christi School outperformed the other schools within the Archdiocese and the Nation in Math, Reading, and Vocabulary.







School Expenses




What does this Mean?

- Generous donors directly support the school


