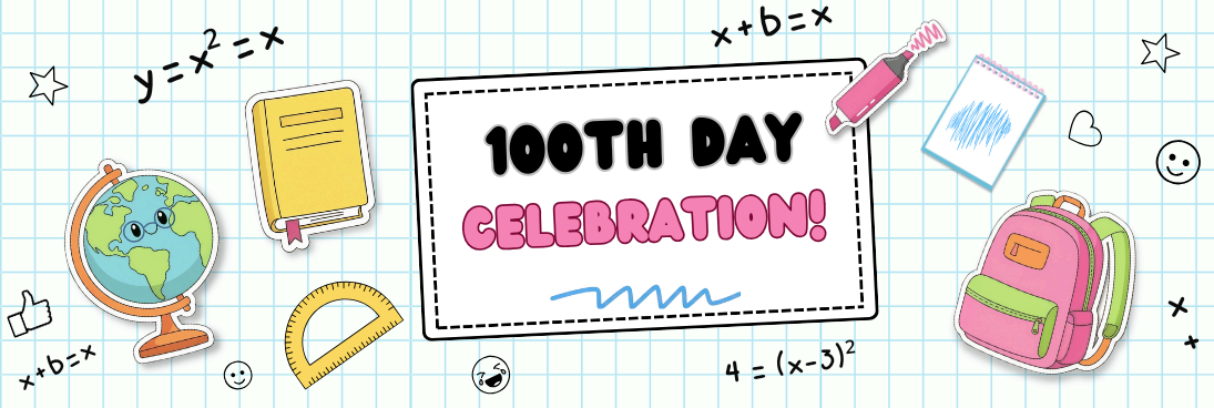

A Message From The School Nurse



Dear Parents/Guardians,

A quick reminder:

Please keep your child home if they are ill, and they must be fever-free for 24 hours without Tylenol or Motrin in order to return to school.

The Flu has been more severe this year, and some kids have rebounded if they return too soon.

Be aware that I will count illness and missed days as one absence. Let me know if your child is sick. I cannot change the automatic response for days past 10, but I will have documentation to support an illness with your help.

I am tracking illness at the school, and the numbers are more accurate if you call or email me to let me know. No call means an unexcused absence. Also, if they have had the GI bug, they must be home for 24 hours after vomiting or diarrhea and be able to eat, drink, and feel well. I am enclosing a sheet for Norovirus, but as with any illness, good hand hygiene is a must!!
