Why did the Board of Education reintroduce a referendum to voters?

- The Board of Education wishes to reduce class sizes, expand gifted education, reinstate junior high sports, and provide summer school transportation.
- Even with four years of cuts and increased fees, the district still has to take temporary loans while awaiting funding payments, due to inadequate reserves.
- Routine building and system maintenance has been deferred for several years, and with buildings and systems aging, it's important that these issues be addressed.

- Necessary capital expenses cannot be covered without the sale of bonds, increasing the district's debt.
- Continued borrowing affects the financial rating of the district.
- A balanced budget isn't sustainable without maintaining the program cuts and fee increases that have taken place over the past several years.
