On the Job Training (OJT)

We offer businesses up to six months of reimbursement for a new hire's wages during the training period. OJT enables you to train new hires to your businesses' exact needs. The program is free to participating businesses, reimbursing a minimum of 50% of wages during the training period.

Pre-Screening and Candidate Sourcing

Every year we work with thousands of job seekers to help them prepare for the workplace and get matched with great opportunities. Our team developed an internal database of job seekers to quickly match candidates based on skills, experience, and geography. As an additional time-saver for you, we pre-screen all candidates prior to forwarding resumes.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW MUCH DO YOUR SERVICES COST?

Our services are provided at **NO COST** to the employer or the candidate. E&ES is funded through public dollars and partnerships.

DO YOU HAVE ANY CANDIDATES NOW?

E&ES works diligently to recruit eligible candidates throughout the entire Chicagoland. The availability of potential candidates for your position depends on the scope of the role and the interests and experience of our talent pipeline.

WHERE DO YOU GET YOUR JOB SEEKER REFERRALS?

E&ES locations throughout the Chicagoland and Suburban areas; our clients come to us from within those communities for employment assistance and are also referred from various local city & state agencies.

WHAT DO YOU NEED FROM ME TO BEGIN PARTNERING?

The first piece of information needed is your Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN). Once it is received, E&ES can create a job profile for your company and begin to input job orders and recruit potential candidates for your positions.

WHAT IS A REVERSE REFERRAL AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

A reverse referral is a true win all around. In this scenario, the business identifies a candidate they would like to hire, but also hopes to participate in OJT. The process is as simple as sending the potential candidate to the E&ES team prior to hiring and providing time to ensure the candidate is eligible for the program. If the candidate meets our eligibility, you can hire through the OJT program. If the candidate does not meet eligibility, you can still hire them outright!

WHAT OTHER SERVICES DOES E&ES PROVIDE BEYOND JOB PLACEMENT?

E&ES and its non-profit partner, The Journey Forward, offer 29 unique programs at 20 locations throughout Cook, DeKalb, Kane, Kendall, and Will Counties. These programs vary from Family Center Coaching, Youth Services, Occupational Training, Trauma-Informed Care and Financial Literacy to name a few.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES IN YOUR PROGRAMS?

Each unique program has its own unique eligibility requirements. For the most part, an eligible candidate must meet some sort of need to exhibit a skill gap relative to the position(s) they are interested in.



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
