### **Teach Like a Champion 2.0**

Teach Like a Champion 2.0 is the follow up to Doug Lemov's popular Teach Like a Champion. The second version is expanded from 49 to 62 techniques that teachers can use in classrooms to build cultures of learning and to engage students in learning. Part 3 of the book, on Ratio, includes 13 techniques that focus specifically on the idea of ratio, or of ensuring that students are doing most of the cognitive work and thinking in the lesson. The book also includes access to videos that demonstrate the techniques in the classroom.
