



DPAS II TEACHER FRAMEWORK CALIBRATION

Calibration is a recommended practice of all educators to ensure a common, shared understanding of what practice looks like at different performance levels. Calibration establishes and maintains consistency in analyzing evidence, providing feedback, and using professional judgment to determine performance level ratings. It is expected for all evaluators to participate in yearly calibration activities.

The DDOE, in coordination with the Danielson Group, will offer a series of 5 online calibration sessions during the 2019-2020 school year. Sessions will be available for the entire month to allow participants the opportunity to complete the webinar at their convenience.
