Schedule an Appointment

Once you are eligible under the Plan, we urge you to schedule an appointment with your assigned contracted dentist for a thorough examination. This appointment will introduce you to your dentist and allow him/her to evaluate your dental health. Once you have had your examination, your dentist will present you with a treatment plan.

Listen to Your Dentist – Ask Questions

It is very important that you fully understand the treatment plan presented by your dentist. There may be several options presented to you, so you will want to ask questions such as; “Which treatment is covered under my plan.” “Which treatment is considered an upgrade or optional?” Ask your dentist to explain the options and the differences between them so you can make an informed decision about your treatment. And always make sure you understand the co-payments associated with the treatment. If you have questions about the co-payments being quoted by your dentist, please call LIBERTY Dental Plan’s Member Services Department for assistance.

Follow the Dentist’s Advice

Your dentist will have a lot of valuable advice for you. Please follow the instructions your dentist gives you for taking care of your teeth. Once you and your dentist have your dental health in “tip top” condition, you are in charge of maintaining it. Remember, you should visit your dentist on a regular basis to have periodic examinations and teeth cleanings. Your coverage with LIBERTY Dental Plan provides this service once each six months. We take pride in our relationship with our dental professionals. This relationship enables our members to receive the care they deserve when enrolling in our plans.

Our goal is to provide you with the comprehensive dental benefits you purchase. We pledge to support your choice of LIBERTY Dental Plan by giving you confidence through the excellent customer service you deserve. After all, isn't that what it is all about!

LIBERTY Dental Plan has been providing and administering dental benefits in California for over twenty-five (25) years. All of our contracted providers have undergone strict credentialing procedures, background checks and office evaluations. In addition, each provider must adhere to strict contractual guidelines. Our Provider Relations Department conducts a Quality Assessment Program which includes ongoing contract management to assure compliance with continuing education, accessibility for members, appropriate diagnosis and treatment planning.

Membership Eligibility: If you reside in our service area, you and your eligible dependents may enroll in this plan. Eligible dependents include your spouse; dependent child up to the child's twenty-sixth (26th) birthday unless such child is eligible for employer-sponsored coverage (other than coverage through the subscriber). The children and spouse of a dependent child are excluded from coverage; disabled children dependent upon you for support and are not able to support themselves due to physical or mental handicap (you must provide proof of disability or handicap at the time you enroll) and adopted or step-children meeting the above requirements.

Selecting a Dental Provider: You must select a contracted Primary Care Dentist when you enroll in this plan and indicate your selection on the enrollment form. This dentist will be responsible for providing dental care for you and your family. If you desire, you may transfer to a different contracted Primary Care Dentist simply by calling our Member Services Department. Transfer requests received by the 20th day of the month will be effective the first day of the following month. Visit www.libertydentalplan.com to view dental office options.

Appointment Scheduling: Once you are enrolled and eligible under the Plan, you may call your Primary Care Dentist directly to schedule an appointment. Be sure to identify yourself as a member of LIBERTY Dental Plan when you call. Co-payments are payable to your provider at the time services are rendered.

Specialty Referral: LIBERTY Dental Plan will arrange for you to receive services from a Contracted Dental Specialist if the necessary treatment is outside the scope of General Dentistry. Your General Dentist will initiate the referral process with LIBERTY Dental Plan. The proper referral process must be utilized for specialty services to be covered under your plan. X-rays for diagnostic purposes are benefits in the General Dentist's office only.

Emergency Dental Care: All contracted Primary Care dental offices provide for emergency dental care twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week. If you are more than fifteen (15) miles or thirty (30) minutes from your Primary Care Dentist, or you cannot contact your Primary Care Dentist or LIBERTY Dental Plan Member Services, simply contact any licensed dentist to receive care. LIBERTY Dental Plan will reimburse you for dental expenses for covered services related to the relief of pain only, up to a maximum of seventy-five dollars (\$75), less any applicable co-payments.
