What Camp Provides:

- Friendly, dedicated camp staff to guide your group through the week

- Lodging and meals
- 3 days of hands-on service alongside local community members
- 1 day of fun exploring the area—think rafting, tubing, hiking, and more
- All tools, equipment, and program supplies

What You Provide:

- Adult supervision (minimum 8:1 youth-to-adult ratio)
- Oversight of medication and health care needs for participants
- Transportation to and from work sites

Sample Weekly Schedule

Sunday: Arrive at camp, team-building, and orientation on disaster recovery

Monday – Thursday: A mix of –

- Community service projects coordinated by LDR Carolinas
- Camp activities like the challenge tower, crafts, and campfires
- Local adventures (rafting, tubing, hiking, sightseeing)

Friday: Closing Worship and departure by 3:30 pm

Each evening includes time for reflection and devotion, led by camp staff or your group's adult leaders.
