School Advisory Councils are . . . a diverse group of stakeholders of a school, established through Florida law, with the shared goal of increasing student achievement in a safe learning environment.

As a member, you would:

- Attend monthly meetings on the fourth Tuesday of every month from 3:15-4:15, beginning September 24, 2024 (except in December).
 - Meetings will be held in the Media Center this year.
- Act as a council member according to established procedures by making suggestions and recommendations representative of the views of parents, citizens, and community organizations of the school community.
 - The SAC will be comprised of an elected membership and a quorum is required to be present before a vote may be taken by the SAC. A majority of the membership (50% + 1) constitutes a quorum.
- Participate in activities aimed at obtaining parent and community support and assistance for school related problems.
 - No member may miss more than two (2) unexcused consecutive SAC meetings. Members must notify the SAC Chair or Principal prior to a meeting to be excused.
- Carry out council assignments including approve professional learning activities and/or educational supplies for which teachers request funds.
- Become knowledgeable about personnel and material resources of the school and community and the school's program.
- Act as resource persons for the SAC, especially in the solutions of community-related problems which affect the school and its students.
- Assist in obtaining community resources to aid the school's education program.
- Serve as a communication link between SAC, the community and the school.
