Thank you so much for being a part of the **Support Local Law Enforcement Community Parade**.

The parade will begin at **10:30 a.m. on Saturday April 8th**. Please be ready to go when it is your turn.

Each entrant must display a banner or sign (homemade is great!) specifically stating "(Your Organization or Business Name) Supports Local Law Enforcement." Example: "F.O.P. Lodge #5 Supports Local Law Enforcement." Banner or sign must be visibly and prominently displayed

Staging for the parade will be between 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM in the 500 Block of N. Main (Between 9th and Central on Main).

Each entry should appoint a captain. It would be the captain's responsibility to check in with an event coordinator along with their parade pass which will be mailed to you prior to the event. It is important to keep the pace of the parade and to make sure your group has a plan for disbanding.

Look for volunteers from the Fraternal Order of Police (Blue Shirts) at Main & Murdock. They will be able to assist you into the staging area.

If you have a trailer, try to arrive early so that we can get you in easier.

Please, only those vehicles that are in the parade are allowed in the staging area.

We would appreciate it if there were no paper handouts, flyers, coupons, etc. You may promote your business or activity with signage on your vehicle or carry them. No inappropriate signage please.

Please do not throw ANYTHING. You can hand out gifts and candy as you walk.

It is very important to not have more than 15-20 ft (a couple of car lengths) and no less than 10 ft between groups. We would appreciate not having any large gaps. That makes for a boring parade. © If the parade is stopped, you may perform skits, dances, etc. Please try to keep the parade moving at all times.

The parade route is from Central and Main south to 1st Street. At 1st Street, you will turn to the right (west) onto 1st Street and proceed one block west to Water Street. The parade route will then proceed north on Water Street to 3rd Street where everyone will disband and either drive away or proceed to their vehicles on foot. There are also several parking lots around that area to which your group can go. The official end of the parade is when you turn at the intersection of 1st Street and Main. Please do not stop in the street. The whole parade is behind you. If you are needing to stop, go to the side of the street so that others can go around you. See map on back.
