Color public health programs span infectious disease and high-burden, actionable, under-diagnosed conditions

- COVID-19 testing, immunization and treatment
- Vaccination software/clinics
- Cancer prevention
- Heart disease
- Diabetes & pre-diabetes
- Hypertension/hyperlipidemia
- Medication response
- HIV/STI



Rapid Testing

General:

- Evolve with changing guidance/test options
- iHealth; Expiration dates extended +3 months
- No reporting
- Flow to treatment/telehealth/antivirals

Phase 1: June:


- Complement to lab-based testing
- Auto-shipment to all sites (state- and privately-run)


Phase 2: July 1

- Can be chosen instead of lab-based testing
- Testing recommended but voluntary
- Self-serve ordering
- Survey: 75% of weekly prefer lab-based tests; 75% of symptomatic prefer rapid tests

Positive for COVID-19?

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in partnership with Color, is offering free telehealth visits to get COVID-19 treatment pills.

Oral antiviral treatment is for people who have had COVID-19 symptoms for 5 days or less. Antiviral treatment can help reduce your chance for severe disease and prevent hospitalization.
