



NOTICE OF STREET CLOSURE

The 34th Annual Apple Fest is returning this Fall to Lincoln Avenue during the first weekend of October. The event will take place **from Lawrence to Wilson Avenues on Saturday, October 2nd and Sunday, October 3rd between the hours of 9am and 6pm**. The festival is being expanded by an additional block this year to provide attendees more space in order to limit crowding.

Lincoln Avenue will close to traffic at approximately 5am on Saturday morning to begin set-up for the event. The street will be re-opened late Sunday evening. The public parking lot at Lincoln and Leland will be closed to vehicles, but the lot at Leland and Western will remain open for the entirety of the weekend.

Traffic on Leland and Eastwood Avenues will be limited to local residential traffic only. Traffic along Lincoln Avenue will be restricted between Lawrence and Wilson Avenues. CTA buses will always have access to the Western Avenue Station during the weekend.

A map of the traffic closures has been provided on the adjacent side of this notice, which depicts pedestrian entrances to the event footprint.
