



COVID-19 Policy and Procedures

In-Person Activities

Eva's Heroes is dedicated to the safety of all its participants and staff. Due to the compromised immune system of many of our participants, the following guidelines are adapted from the CDC to ensure our participants can remain as safe and healthy as possible while attending our programs. All participants and staff attending in-person activities must follow the policy below.

All individuals must provide documentation of having received a full COVID-19 vaccine OR provide documentation of a negative COVID-19 test result within 72 hours prior to the activity.

All individuals must complete a health screen questionnaire and will have their temperature taken upon arrival. Those individuals determined to be at risk of having COVID-19 based on the questionnaire and temperature check may not be allowed to participate in the activity at the discretion of an Eva's Heroes representative.

Participants will be asked to sanitize their hands upon arrival with provided hand sanitizer.

All individuals are encouraged to wear a mask and remain socially distanced while participating in the activity.

Any individual who is feeling ill or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should not attend an in-person activity.

Any individual that tests positive for COVID-19 or has been in direct contact with someone who has COVID-19, must contact Eva's Heroes.

If a participant, volunteer, or staff member is diagnosed with COVID-19, all potentially affected individuals will be contacted, and HIPAA/CDC Guidelines will be followed.

If a participant, volunteer, or staff member is diagnosed with COVID-19, the following three requirements must be met to return to an Eva's Heroes program:

- At least 24 hours have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medication)
- The individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath)
- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

If anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19, we ask that you please notify us. We also ask that the participant refrain from attending in-person activities for a minimum of 10 days.

If an individual travels outside of the country, that individual must take a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after arrival in the USA. If the test is negative, the individual may attend the in-person activity.
