**The January Kenya Team (Jered McKenna, Daniel Myles, and Rick Blackwell)** ask that you pray for safe travels to Nairobi, Kenya this Sunday, January 15. Invited by supported missionaries Tohru & Claire Inoue (SIM/S Sudan), they will lead worship at the annual Spiritual Life Conference for the S. Sudan-based missionaries.
