We will do everything on our end to keep the Pelican Point Golf Course a true success, but we truly need the help and support of all our residents and the HOA. Many golf courses in the area have closed over the years — The Island in Plaquemine, Sherwood Forest, Briarwood and Shenandoah.

BREC in Baton Rouge subsidizes its golf courses at a cost of over \$3 Million dollars in losses each year.

Nationally, over the last eight years, each week has seen another golf course close.

National statistics show that when a golf course closes, the homes lose 30% of value across the board. If Pelican Point is forced to close the doors, the average homeowner is subject to lose \$100,000 to \$150,000 each in property value, plus the beauty, ambiance and social opportunities that the course and clubhouse offers.

Like so many other establishments, the Pelican Point Golf Club, is struggling through this pandemic, but WE REMAIN OPEN. We have had to cut back our staff hours, and reduced our expenses where possible to tighten our belts like many others.
