

Auto Value Scholarship Instructions – Canadians

All Canadian applicants must fill out the Auto Value application. Filling out the Canadian application with NOT qualify you for consideration. The first page of the application will direct you to a separate application for Canadian students, but you MUST REMAIN on the U.S. page if you would like to be considered eligible. You may also fill out the Canadian application for other scholarships, but it will not qualify you for the Auto Value scholarships. Contact schavey@alliance1.com with any questions.

- 2.) Click Auto Value from the panel on the right:

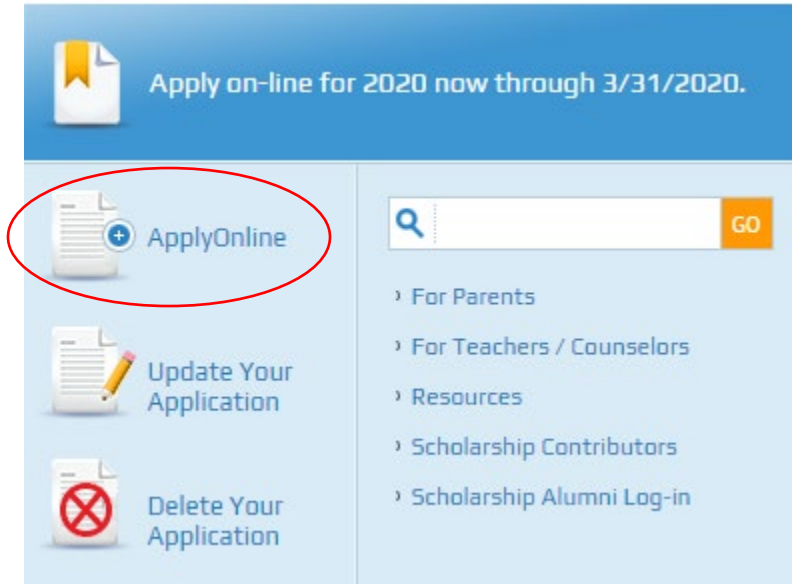

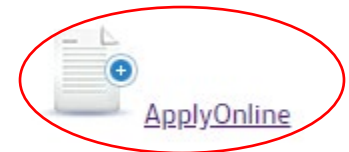
b.) Apply online at automotivescholarships.com and complete your application no later than March 31, 2020. You must also note Auto Value in the sponsor section under “contact name.”

Who Qualifies for this Scholarship?

- Graduating high school seniors planning to be full time students at any of the above
- No GPA requirement
