The right candidate will provide specialized training to youth and young adults between the ages of 16 and 24 who are at risk of not completing or have not completed their high school education. Youthbuild participants are trained in construction and other fields in the building trades, basic academic skills, and leadership. They also receive construction-based work experience.

This rewarding work will include providing hands-on and classroom instruction following a construction-based curriculum for cohorts of youth and young adults throughout the year; being responsible for making various connections in the community with partnering organizations, employers, and agencies that serve youth; and setting up work experiences for youth in the community.

The ability to interact with youth customers in both groups and individually is vital. Engaging interpersonal skills and excellent verbal and written communication skills are a must. Applicants should be computer proficient in word processing, e-mail, internet, and accessing information. The right candidate will be a vocationally certified instructor in the construction field or to have related experience; have at least one year of client service experience; be able to provide their own dependable transportation; and be able to travel to complete job duties and transport youth. A Bachelor's degree in education, counseling, or a construction-related field or a combination of related degree with appropriate experience is preferred.
