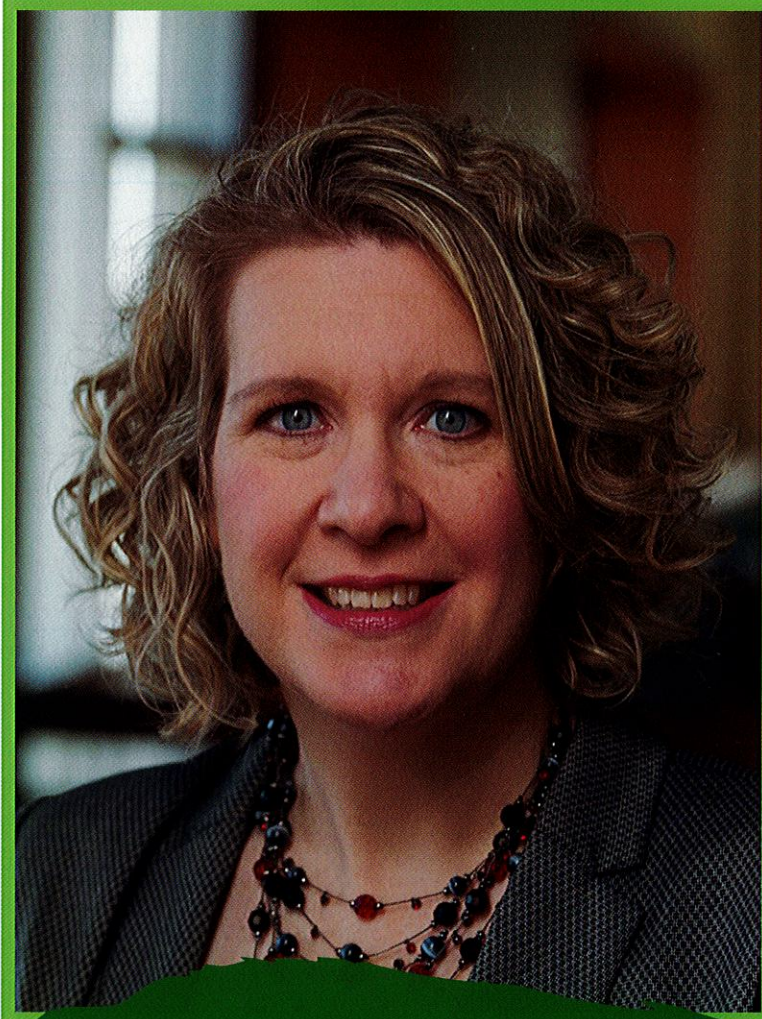


Aging Studies Program Annual Lecture:
