ABOUT THESE WORKSHOPS

Rachel Jeske, a member of the Potawatomi Hannahville Indian Community and a parent of ICS students and alumni, is our instructor for both Workshops. She has been making and teaching others how to make Eastern Woodland center seam moccasins here at our school for the past two years. Each set of moccasins will be made from one piece of leather. There are no needles or thread involved, you will weave thin strips of leather back and forth through punched holes. This style is great for beginners and comes together quickly.

Be prepared to take your shoes off so you can trace your feet and take some measurements. If you would like to make the moccasins for someone else, bring a tracing of their feet and instep measurement (the measurement around the arch of the foot).

Materials provided include: scissors, hole punches, rulers, pen/pencils, paper to make your pattern and enough leather for one pair of moccasins. Lunch will also be provided.
