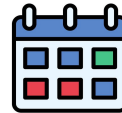

Help set your child up for success with these helpful hints!

Be aware of the testing dates.

Your child's teacher will be communicating specific information with you.



Be well rested.

Plan bedtime 30-60 minutes earlier than usual. Turn off the TV, video-games, and computers earlier in the evening.



Eat a good breakfast.
