Must be a resident of Wisconsin

## **Art Contest Rules and Guidelines**

- Students are asked to submit a piece of artwork that reflects this year's conference theme.
- Artwork will be judged by the Parent Advisory Committee of the WR Native Youth Prevention Coalition based on the following criteria:
  - Originality and creativity
  - Relationship of work to the theme: 12 Nations, 2 Worlds, 1 People
- The submitted artwork cannot be larger than 11x17". We cannot accept three dimensional pieces.
- Each piece of artwork must be submitted with an official Application and Release form.
- One submission per student
- **The winning selection will receive \$150, runner up receiving \$50**

## **Contest Deadline**

Artwork must be submitted no later than **Friday, February 15, 2019**. Entries that are mailed must be postmarked by that date.
