**Lord Jesus Christ, Almighty God, Sovereign Lord, we pray that you would deliver us, halt this global virus and break its power.**

- God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore, we will not fear. Psalms 46:1-2
- Surely, He will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; His faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. **We pray for all medical professionals and caregivers.** Lord God, as more people get sick, healthcare workers and first responders are working longer hours with fewer supplies and with more risk of contracting the coronavirus themselves. Renew their energy and sustain them on long shifts. Bring Your protection upon them as they work with patients. Multiply their supplies so they have the protective items needed to stay safe on the job.

- Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. Psalm 23:4

**God of all Comfort and Counsel, we pray for those who are grieving,** reeling from the sudden loss of loved ones.
