

Examples of position that fall into the non-sensitive Position Sensitivity Level (Level 1)

AO sponsors registering individuals in NED will see that the majority of positions at NIH entail low-risk, non-sensitive, and non-national security program responsibilities. Below is a sampling of position types and their corresponding sensitivity level 1 that are published in the 2866 worksheet. For illustration purposes, this table shows only positions that have a corresponding position sensitivity Level 1.
