


## Day 1 - God's Extraordinary Gift

God has always raised up "an army" of volunteers who have loved, prayed for, and supported CGS with their gifts of time, money, and loving service. Our prayer is that God will use all the preparation, the beautifully decorated building, the gifts for their children and youth, and the words spoken during their visit to soften hearts and create an atmosphere where they can hear and receive the Gospel.

Lucy is raising three grandchildren, Doris is raising one, Frank, a widower, is raising three. The list is long and their gratitude for this ministry is priceless. Their number one prayer request is for God to help them as they raise those entrusted to their care. Their financial resources are very limited since the overwhelming majority of these senior adults only receive a small Social Security check.

Our Heavenly Father cares more than we can comprehend for the needs of children and Godly family members who take them into their homes. May we comfort each one as they are our guests at the shop with the words, "Immanuel, GOD IS WITH US!" May God grant that each child will come to know personally the God who will never allow them "to hunger or thirst."

## Day 3 - The Extraordinary Light


"Jackie" entered the Christmas Gift Shop exhausted and sad. Her husband was in the hospital and very sick. It was Christmastime, and not only did she not have money for gifts, but her limited income was not paying all the bills. Her husband had been ill and hospitalized for several weeks, so their income was greatly reduced. Jo Bailey, then Christmas Gift Shop Coordinator, introduced me to "Jackie" and I took her to the age appropriate rooms for her to choose gifts for her children. Afterwards, we headed to the buddy room where I offered her refreshments and shared with her the greatest gift anyone can receive — Jesus Christ. "Jackie" prayed and asked Christ to come into her life that day. The next year, a knock came at the back door of the shop. There stood "Jackie" with a \$100 bill in her hand. Jo invited her to come in and she said, "I just wanted to give something back to help someone else." Jo thanked her and said, "Let me show you the shop; it's more beautiful this year than last year." As they walked through the building, "Jackie" exclaimed, "There it is! That's the room where I became a Christian! It will always be the most beautiful room to me."

The truth is, when I shared with "Jackie," she was so tired and burdened that I truly wondered if her decision was genuine or just a response to nice people for being helpful to her at a difficult time. Isaiah 55:11 tells us *"So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it."* It is a wonderful joy to know that our witness is never in vain! We will never know all the results of our giving and sharing of the Gospel at CGS, but we can be sure God does not waste that which is done in His Name.

## Day 4 - An Extraordinary Shepherd

Every Christmas Gift Shop, there are parents who are terminally ill, children who are critically sick, families devastated by terrible fires, women who have been brutally abused, and persons who have been imprisoned. There are many in deep distress over the problems and life choices of their children. Heart attacks and strokes have forever altered the lives of some parents. The list of needs is long that result in financial hardship. Who can provide comfort, direction in life, and the ability to move to a place of wholeness other than "THE GREAT SHEPHERD OF THE SHEEP?"

When David says, "He makes me to lie down in green pastures," he is saying, "My shepherd makes me lie down in his finished work. With his own pierced hands, Jesus created a pasture for the soul. He tore out the thorny underbrush of condemnation. He pried loose the huge boulders of sin. In their place, he planted seeds of grace and dug ponds of mercy. His pasture is a gift to us. This is not a pasture that we have made. Nor is it a pasture that we deserve. It is a gift of God." (Max Lucado)

This is THE MESSAGE that allows us to share with confidence — IN CHRIST there is HOPE for all of life's problems and circumstances. *Jesus said, "I am the door. If anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." (John 10:9)*


Last year, "Celia" needed help with gifts for her children. Her husband lost his leg and money was tight. They have a 15 year-old son with special needs and an 11 year-old daughter who has had five heart surgeries. "Celia" did not have a relationship with Jesus. The volunteer helped her to understand that she does not have to live life on her own, and that Jesus can be with her in all things as well as give her hope and a unique joy throughout her life. "Celia" chose to enter through "The Door." She "found pasture," and left with a peace that only Jesus can provide!

Through the years, over 800 have chosen to enter through "the door." God has used the testimonies and gospel witness of the chaplains and buddies serving in the Christmas Gift Shop ministry to articulate the invitation of Jesus. One of the miracles we see repeated every year at CGS is God matching the "right" buddy with the guest who needs to hear what that buddy can uniquely articulate about salvation. The transformed life in Christ matched with the person needing to hear that message is truly something only the extraordinary Lord Jesus can accomplish. What a privilege it has been to watch God work!

Why focus on the "I AM's" in scripture? We begin to perceive how deeply God loves us and how outrageous His plan to save us truly is! "He is the tender Father who cannot bear to be separated from His children, who, in fact, is driven to reveal the extent of His love by performing the greatest miracle of all – allowing his Son to become one of us, to take us by the hand and lead us out of darkness. Christmas Gift Shop began with a prayer to use the season of Christmas to share the gospel message with those in our county who need gifts for their children and youth. The largeness of this ministry requires over 1,000 volunteers to give and serve each year. Thousands of dollars worth of gifts are needed. A prepared building in which to conduct CGS was a critical need from the beginning. This ministry has been the largest evangelistic ministry of our associational churches for 23 years. God raised up an army of people within our churches who love and support CGS every year. God uses this ministry to create a fellowship among our churches as we do local missions together!

CGS has not only touched countless lives in Shelby County, but it has been a model for other Alabama associations as well as associations in Florida and Tennessee. All of this is a result of continuous, consistent prayer and service of persons in our SBA family of churches.

## Day 7 - An Extraordinary Eternal Home

We stand on holy ground in the Christmas Gift Shop. God has done amazing things in the lives of volunteers and parents alike over the years as He has brought them together to share appointment times.

Phyllis Page is a well-known and loved volunteer who has experienced life with and without Christ. She has walked a path with physical difficulties and has known tragedy with the shock of her husband's sudden death. God has given her the ability to communicate the Gospel in a clear and powerful way that draws others to the Savior.

Last December, "James" and his wife arrived at the gift shop, and were introduced to their buddies. One of them was Phyllis. "James" shared that he was ill and not sure he could walk long enough to choose the gifts for their children. However, "James" was able to shop for their children and was thrilled he could help choose their gifts. While sitting in the buddy room waiting for the gifts to be wrapped, "James" shared that he had been diagnosed with cancer in August and had to quit work. His cancer was terminal, and he had little time. Phyllis immediately asked him about his relationship to Christ. "James" said he knew the Lord and was going to heaven. It just so happened that day was the anniversary of the death of Phyllis's husband. This provided the opportunity for her to share her own painful journey. For the first time "James" and his wife found the freedom to begin talking about his approaching death. The visit to the gift shop led them to be able to address several issues as well as plan for his funeral.

As Phyllis headed home that day, she remembered a letter her husband had written her. Not knowing of his fate, he had the foresight to write this letter to her in the event of his death. He told her and their family where he had put it. After his tragic death, Phyllis's son remembered the letter, and they read it as a family. It was "a hug from Heaven," she said, and it provided a closeness and encouragement that she could have never imagined. Phyllis believed God was leading her to get in touch with "James" to tell him about the letter and encourage him to write his family. He was delighted she called and told her he would write them before the day ended.


The family found the letters after his death on January 16<sup>th</sup>, less than five weeks after coming to CGS. The letters continue to comfort his wife and children.


