

**What:** RBC Kids - Re-opening!  
**When:** Sunday School, September 20  
Preschool Extended Care, September 20  
Chase Place (K—2nd Grade), September 27  
**How:** **Pre-register** by Wednesday of each week

***What will be the same?***

- Enthusiastic teachers
- Engaging lessons focused on the Word of God
- Simple snacks

***What will be different?***

- **Wear masks** if you are over two years old.
- **Check your temperature.**
  - Onsite checks will be provided for staff and teachers of babies-two's.
  - At home checks are required to ensure teachers and children are fever free for more than 24 hours, not taking fever medication, and not showing common signs of COVID (sore throat, cough, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath for unknown reasons, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever at or greater than 100 degrees fahrenheit).
- **Answer screening questions at check-in.**
- **Drop off point:** Children's Portico from 9:10 - 10:15 a.m.
  - Encourage children who can walk to walk in (rather than the parent holding the child) so that our team can easily take them to class.
  - Leave pertinent instructions at the top of the diaper bag for our smallest children.
  - Use the stairwell nearest the welcome center to go to the adult Sunday School classroom or the sanctuary if it is worship time (no need to pick up the older children between Sunday School and church).
- **Pick up point:** starts in the fellowship hall
  - Go directly to the Fellowship Hall by using the stairwell **nearest the sanctuary.**
  - Our team will walk you to your child's/children's classroom or classrooms in a one-way direction to receive the children and allow you to exit through the children's portico. Starting September 27th, the children from Chase Place will meet you in the fellowship hall before you proceed to pick up the other children as you exit.
- Teachers will prepare "box cars," circles, hoops, play borders, and chairs spaced 6-feet apart to encourage social distancing.
- Rooms will be more carefully cleaned and sanitized between usage.
