

RBC KIDS GOALS

YOUNGER PRESCHOOL

- Point to the Bible and pictures of Jesus
- Help open the Bible and turn Bible Pages
- Serve in a small way (clean up, set up, etc.)
- Say "Bible", "Jesus", "God".

OLDER PRESCHOOL

- Say that the Bible tells that God sent Jesus to Earth
- Open the Bible to a specific (marked) verses or passage
- Say that there are two main parts to the Bible: OT and NT

KINDERGARTEN

- Name a few Bible books in order
- Remember and retell familiar Bible stories or facts
- Know a Bible reference is a book, chapter, and verse
- Know the chapter is the big number and the verse is the small number

1ST GRADE

- Name the Fruit of the Spirit
- Explain what the Bible is and why it's important
- Identify the 4 Gospels and their authors
- Know the difference between the OT and NT
- Locate all books of the Bible using the Table of Contents Page

2ND GRADE

- Recite the names of every book in the NT
- Retell the story of Creation
- Name the Divisions of the Bible (5 OT, 5 NT)
- Memorize 12 new verses
- Find a specific verse in the Bible on your own

3RD GRADE

- Locate the names of prominent Bible people in the books where their stories are recorded
- Memorize 12 new verses
- Name the genres of the Bible (6)
- Know the Bible is without error and will never change
- Recite the names of every book in the OT

4TH GRADE

- Know that the Bible is the only inspired, written Word of God
- Recite the 10 Commandments
- Summarize the Gospel in your own words
- Memorize 12 new verses
- Locate all books of the Bible in a limited time frame

5TH GRADE

- Name books in each of the Divisions & Genres
- Memorize 12 new verses
- Explain what a prophet is
- Quote key passages when given the reference
- Know how to use the Bible to tell someone the Gospel
