Visit the animals outside the arena entrance. Talk to the Fair Volunteers and Farmers' Market vendors. Have fun while learning more about where your food comes from.

Pickup your questionnaire at the market entrance or Information booth. Be sure to drop off your completed questionnaire at the same place you picked it up before you leave the grounds.
