Kids Backing Kids, Inc. is a Wellesley nonprofit co-founded by three WPS students to help local children experiencing poverty, homelessness, food insecurity, and trauma (www.kidsbackingkids.org). For instance, prior to the start of school this fall, the more than 30 youth volunteers, working with WPS and Town officials, delivered over 160 backpacks with new school supplies to children in our local communities.
