Early Childhood Care and Education Services- TEACHER

Under the guidance of the Lead Teacher, the Teacher collaborates in the planning, implementing, and evaluating of developmentally appropriate curriculum for children in the Early Childhood Care and Education Services (ECCES) as prescribed by the National Association of the Education of Young Children. The Teacher shares the responsibility with the Lead Teacher to set up the physical (indoor and outdoor) environment to meet changing needs, maintains a safe, clean, and pleasant environment, models and instructs other adults in best practice, and provides information to parents regarding their children as well as general child development information. The Teacher is also responsible for assuring compliance with codes of all State and local governing contracting agencies; and works cooperatively and collegially with other staff members of the Early Childhood Care and Education Services Department.

Desirable qualifications: AA or BA degree preferred in Early Childhood Education/Child Development or related field. Familiarity with Title V, CA Dept. of Ed. Early Learning Foundations and NAEYC Accreditation guidelines.

Minimum qualifications: Minimum of 12 units in ECE (core units), Associate Teacher Child Development permit working towards a Teacher permit issued through the California Commission on Teaching Credentialing. 1 year of experience in Early Childhood Education field (can include student teaching)

Special Conditions: Satisfactory completion of a required fingerprint background check. Completion of online CA Mandated Reporter Training in accordance with Title 22. Acceptable Health Screening to include negative TB test results (valid within 1 year of hire date), and proof of required immunizations. Must possess valid Pediatric CPR and First Aid certification prior to start date. Maintains California State Child Development Permit.
