We are pleased to share our Winter Enrichment Plans with elementary families for this coming year. Teachers have put together class offerings from their interests and skills, and we have worked with community partners and guest artists to create an exciting and enriching line-up of classes and experiences. *Please look over the class offerings with your student and help them prioritize areas of interest to learn or deepen their practice.* Students will fill out preference forms in class on Thursday, January 4<sup>th</sup> you are also welcome to turn in a form with your child's preferences to their classroom teacher before that time.

### **Basket Making** *Instructor: Bre Miller (1<sup>st</sup> Grade Teacher)*

We will explore basket and container making with a variety of supplies and techniques. Please bring your creativity, patience and excitement!

### **Lights, Cameras, Action!** *Instructor: Emily Leonard (1<sup>st</sup> Grade Teacher)*

Students will use both imaginary and real-life props to perform in a small group and will develop improv and pantomime skills through fun theater games and activities.

### **Recycled Art Creations** *Instructor: Jenny Melnick (Kindergarten Teacher)*

We'll be reusing and recycling T-shirts into scarfs, bags, bracelets and necklaces. You can make fun and colorful accessories for yourself or as gifts for family and friends. We will NOT be sewing, but we will be practicing tying knots. We may also try a few different techniques for decorating your fabric creations.

### **Science in Motion!** *Instructors: Amy Coe (Kindergarten Teacher) and Melissa Mock*

Learn about science concepts and develop ways to share your knowledge through movement.

### **Float, Height and Flight** *Instructor: Kim Post (2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Teacher)*

Each week we will explore a different engineering theme. You will have challenges to build cargo boats, tall buildings and things that fly out of ordinary materials. You will learn to think, draw models and then build models much like an engineer! Expect to be excited and to be frustrated at the same time! It will be a totally hands on fun time for all!

### **Play Marimba with Mark!** *Instructor: Mark Oesterle (K-8 Music Specialist)*

We'll explore the world of Marimba music as we learn about the instruments, experiment with rhythm and create our own tunes. A not to miss experience—so come join the fun!

### **Cooking Around the World** *Instructor: Gabrielle White (Kindergarten Teacher)*

Do you love to eat delicious food? Be sure to bring your appetite and enthusiasm as we will prepare and enjoy foods from all over the world such as dumplings, guacamole, sushi, and even some sweet treats!

### **Watercolor Painting** *Instructor: Marilyn Fox (2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher)*

While listening to different types of music, we will use our imaginations and brushes to form beautiful paintings using color, mood and different techniques.

### **Spanish** *Instructor: Jenny Brooks (Elementary Counselor)*

Bienvenidos! We will be learning some basic Spanish vocabulary through games, role playing and crafts. I hope you're able to join me!

### **Wheels: Skates and Scooters** *Instructor: Domingo Gomez (Elementary PE)*

Learn how to ride a scooter and roller skate for the first time or to work on more advanced skills for those who already know have some experience. This is a great class that teaches patience, perseverance and helps boost self-confidence.

### **Printmaking Creations!** *Instructor: Trevor Johnson (K-8 Art Specialist)*

Students will get the chance to explore various printmaking processes to create unique personal work as well as a collaborative group project.

## ***K – 2 Guest Artist Classes (Each student will have at least 1 class with a guest artist)***

### **Beginning Breakdance** *Instructor: Anna Nagy - Metropolis Dance*

Students will groove to hip-hop dance steps and learn basic breakdance moves while enhancing coordination and muscle memory skills. We'll learn basic dance steps and arm movements. Students will work on foot work such as top rock and 6-step.

### **Magic Performance!** *Instructor: Ruben Barron*

You'll learn the secrets that started Houdini, Blackstone and David Copperfield on their roads to fame. It's magic with coins, cards, silks and ropes, plus mind tricks and great escapes, and yes, levitation. You'll pick up lots of performing skills from this professional magician as you practice on each other and by the end of the session, you will perform magic and astound your invited audience.

### **Clay Art with Faye!** *Instructor: Faye Baker*

We will be exploring the magical medium of clay! It's a little bit play, a little bit creativity, a little bit technique, and a whole lot of fun! Two projects will be completed in this mini pottery session- Winter Wonderland and Expressive Mask.

### **Mural Art Installation** *Instructor: Urban Artworks*

Working within a theme and expressing themselves and their community, each group will use their creativity and skills to design and paint a mural for inside the school that will remain for years.
