The spectacle of large numbers of migrating hawks, eagles, falcons and other 'raptors' has always captivated people. Historical accounts of this phenomenon in NH date back to the 1700's. A premier New England hawk watch site is atop Pack Monadnock Mountain in Peterborough.

Phil Brown, Raptor Observatory Coordinator for NH Audubon, will review the history of hawk watching in NH, detail the ongoing monitoring efforts, and provide some analysis of migration trend data.
