In partnership with the Redevelopment Authority, I worked to ensure the County-owned park police building across from the Beacon Heights-East Pines Purple Line station will be redeveloped into multifamily housing and retail, including 250 units of affordable housing. The Special Operations Division will be vacating the space in fall 2023 before construction begins.
