Living by the New Rules

A Quarantine Manners Guide for Complying with COVID-19 Emergency Orders

Safety drives the COVID-19 mission. We empower you to join the Village in its Call-to-Action to keep all Key Biscayners home and safe #KBStayHome. The best way to avoid illness and be safe is to avoid exposure to COVID-19.

Emergency Orders: How to enforce them in Condominiums, Apartments, and Multi-Family Residences

- **County Emergency Order 06-20:** Closure of all parks, beaches and recreational facilities.
- **County Emergency Order 15-20:** All pools, hot tubs, golf courses, tennis courts, basketball courts, fitness centers, gymnasiums and other common use amenities, whether of a commercial or non-commercial nature, are closed for all purposes.
 - Lock down entrances to all common use amenities, including beach access and pool decks
 - Post sign informing residents that they are not allowed to use these areas, even if they are bringing their own seating and/or practicing physical distancing
- **Village Emergency Order 6-20: Mandates** facial covering for employees and customers at all times while inside essential businesses—all essential workers **must** wear a facial covering. **Encourages** facial covering for all persons that are outside of their homes.
- **County Emergency Order 20-20:** Persons working in or visiting . . . locations where social distancing measures are not possible shall wear facial coverings as defined by the CDC.
 - Post sign or infographic at all entrances informing essential workers that they must wear a CDC compliant facial covering in order to enter

It is imperative to remember: We cannot gather in groups larger than 10 people, and we must maintain physical distancing, 6-foot intervals. We, as one Village, need to flatten the curve of COVID-19, and we are requesting all Key Biscayners and Essential Workers to do their part.
