AMENDMENT 2 TO EMERGENCY ORDER 20-1


On March 13, 2020, the Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne issued a Declaration of a State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Thereafter, the Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne Issued Emergency Order 20-1, as amended, establishing a curfew to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Key Biscayne. Similarly, on September 14, 2020, the Mayor of Miami-Dade County issued Emergency Order 27-20, establishing a countywide curfew as the minimum standard within Miami-Dade County. On April 7, 2021, the Mayor of Miami-Dade County issued Amendment No. 5 to Emergency Order 27-20, ending the countywide curfew as the minimum standard within Miami-Dade County due to the increasing number of individuals vaccinated against COVID-19 and the stabilization of COVID-19 infection rates.

Therefore, by virtue of the powers and duties vested in me as the Interim Village Manager of the Village of Key Biscayne, Miami-Dade County, Florida, in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes, Chapter 9 of the Village Code, and Resolution No. 2019-55 of the Village of Key Biscayne Village Council adopting the Village's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and pursuant to the Village's Declaration of a State of Emergency issued at 4:20 p.m. March 13, 2020, I hereby find that current public health guidance, COVID-19 vaccinations rates, and the stabilization of COVID-19 infection cases support the termination of the curfew currently in effect within the jurisdictional limits of the Village of Key Biscayne.

Accordingly, I hereby issue this Emergency Order terminating the curfew currently in effect between the hours of 11:00 PM and 5:00 AM within the Village of Key Biscayne **effective April 20, 2021.**
