WHAT'S CLOSED ON THE KEY?

Updated: March 24, 2020

Miami-Dade County parks and beaches are closed until further notice, including the Village Green and the beaches in Crandon Park, Hobie and Key Biscayne.



All boating activities, marinas, boat launches, docking, fueling, marine supply and other marina services, with the exception of commercial fishermen who provide food for restaurants and markets, in Miami-Dade County are closed.



The **Key Biscayne Community Center** will remain closed until further notice.



All bars and restaurants for dining in within Miami-Dade County are closed; kitchens can remain open for take-out, delivery or curbside pickup options.



Non-essential, non-residential travel into and through the Village of Key Biscayne is limited and restricted.



Non-essential retail and commercial establishments in Miami-Dade County are closed until further notice.



CURFEW WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT FROM 10:00PM TO 5:00AM UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
