# WHAT'S CLOSED ON THE KEY?

Updated: March 24, 2020

**Miami-Dade County parks and beaches** are closed until further notice, including the Village Green and the beaches in Crandon Park, Hobie and Key Biscayne.



**All boating activities, marinas, boat launches, docking, fueling, marine supply and other marina services**, with the exception of commercial fishermen who provide food for restaurants and markets, in Miami-Dade County are closed.



The **Key Biscayne Community Center** will remain closed until further notice.



**All bars and restaurants for dining in** within Miami-Dade County are closed; kitchens can remain open for take-out, delivery or curbside pickup options.



**Non-essential, non-residential travel** into and through the Village of Key Biscayne is limited and restricted.



**Non-essential retail and commercial establishments** in Miami-Dade County are closed until further notice.



**CURFEW WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT FROM 10:00PM TO 5:00AM UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.**
