
CONGRATUATIONS TO MY TEAM



LERF PRESIDENT

Jean Wilder, President, PCC





Our second opinion process for patients being referred to Boston is really working well. We have referred over 25 patients. Recently we had a patient with a bent optic nerve, detached retina, and dislocated lens and he was able to obtain an appointment in three and a half months, we were able to get him into Mass Eye and Ear in five days. He had 3 visits, surgery and a follow up visit before his original appointment. This was integral in saving his sight, and he is so grateful and asked me to tell the Lions "THANK YOU, you saved my sight"!!!!. Another patient needed to get to New England Eye Center at Tufts and could not get an appointment until September, we were able to get this patient in for an appointment in four days. The only reason we are able to get this care for these patients is because you Lions have given over \$40,000,000 since 1951, and these researchers are so grateful for our support in their research.



Your MLERF is going strong this year, and your Board of Directors (BOD) are working hard for you. We have just completed the updating of the MLERF Policy Manual, Constitution & By Laws, and created a new Orientation guide, all of which are now available on our website at MLERFi.com

Fundraising is our primary activity, so that we can support our grants for research at Boston Children's Hospital, Mass Eye & Ear Infirmary, New England Eye Center at Tufts University, Boston University, Schepens Eye Research Institute, Joslin Diabetes Center and others. This year our goal is to raise \$1,000,000. Each club has been given a "President's Challenge goal" (which is based on each club's 20 year donation history) and this is listed on our website. IF every club in MD33 meets or beats their suggested goal, then the \$1,000,000 goal will be easily attainable. Over 20 clubs in MD33 have currently beat their goal, it would be great if more clubs could beat their goals, and if we could get 100% participation from all the Lions and Leo clubs in MD33, with a minimum donation of \$100. Please don't wait until the last minute to send your donations in before the books close on July 1. To date we have raised about \$522,000, and we have 3 districts who's final advisory meetings are in the near future. Please let us know about your fundraising events for MLERF and we will help you to advertise on our Facebook page and to our directors.



Congratulations to those individuals and clubs who were recognized at Midwinters for the MLERF recognition awards. This year has been an amazing journey visiting clubs I've never to visited before and meeting so many new Lions, and friends. Thank you for your support and for allowing me the honor of serving as your President of Mass Lions Eye Research Fund. You are AMAZING!!! THANK YOU!







