Our classes are centered around the students experiences and learning, rather than the goal of a final theatrical production. Our class is often based around a central character building theme or topic, and we will spend time exploring that topic using theatre, dance, music, and art.

Virtually everyone can take photos. Instagram, Facebook, SnapChat are just some of the many platforms that allow us to share our photos and experiences. Most often though, there tends to be dramatic differences in photos by amateurs versus images taken by professional photographers. That's because professionals have an understanding of visual elements and technical knowledge that allows them to capture the image the way they see fit. This photography seminar is an introduction to camera basics (settings, ISO, Aperture, Shutter Speed), learning how all those buttons can affect and change the image you create. Also, we will work on artistic techniques of photography (composition) . Photography can be a fun adventure but can also bring out creativity skills and technical skills that help us understand the power of images to communicate perspectives. \*\*Students should bring their own manual camera if available (not a cell phone or point-and-shoot camera).
