Health Information

What do I need to provide the nurse's office?

Students entering grades 6-8 that were enrolled in a District 107 school during 2016-2017 school year already have records on file. Teachers will have access to students' health conditions and emergency health plans. Please update the summer school nurse if there are any changes.

School Board Policy 7:100 requires the most recent physical and immunization record must be on file. If a student was not enrolled in a District 107 school, they will need to fill out an Emergency Health Form. Please notify the nurse if your child has an Emergency or Health Plan in place at his/her present school. If your child was not enrolled in District 107, you must submit a health form, immunization record and recent physical with your registration.

Nurse Notes:

Does your child have Asthma, a Food or Bee Allergy, or other Health Conditions?

- Please remember that if your child has an Inhaler or Epi-Pen that they carry at school, to notify the Summer School Nurse.
- Children prescribed an Inhaler or Epi-Pen should have them available during summer school in case of an emergency.
- Appropriate medication forms should be on file.
- Students may need an Emergency Care Plan (ECP) developed by the school nurse to be shared with teachers and coaches that have a need to know.

Most often though, there tends to be dramatic differences in photos by amateurs versus images taken by professional photographers. That's because professionals have an understanding of visual elements and technical knowledge that allows them to capture the image the way they see fit. This photography seminar is an introduction to camera basics (settings, ISO, Aperture, Shutter Speed), learning how all those buttons can affect and change the image you create. Also, we will work on artistic techniques of photography (composition) . Photography can be a fun adventure but can also bring out creativity skills and technical skills that help us understand the power of images to communicate perspectives. **Students should bring their own manual camera if available (not a cell phone or point-and-shoot camera).

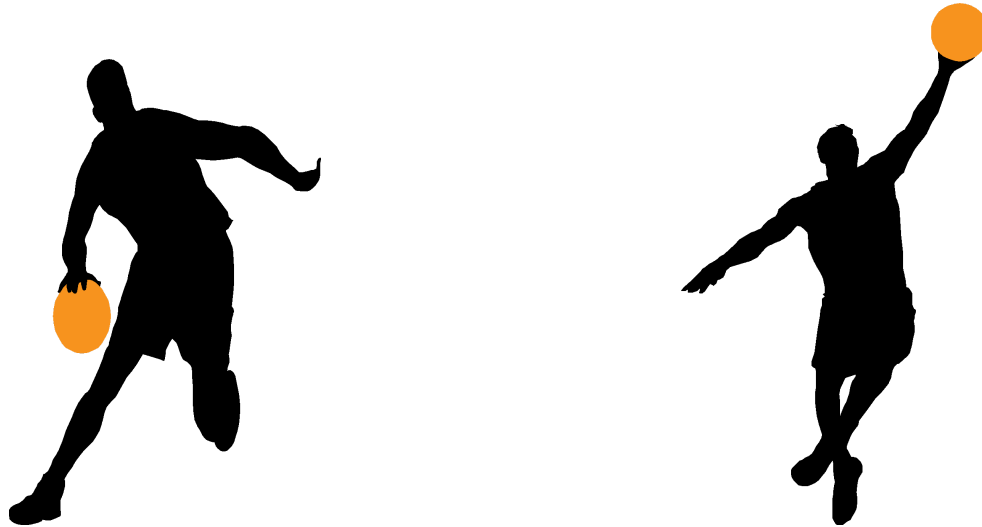

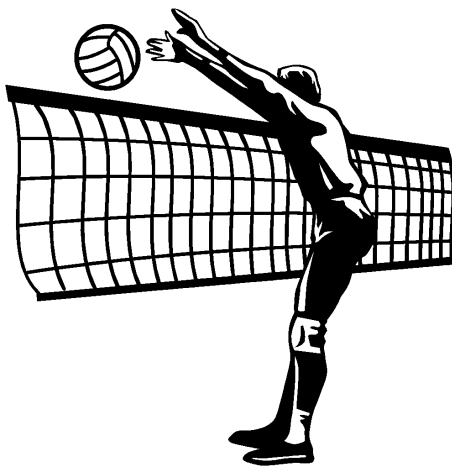
