Guidelines and Payment



1. Prepare Digital Image Files:

still images e-mailed or sent in on a thumbdrive, as JPGs, each not to exceed 1024(w) x 768(h) pixels when set at 72 dpi, not exceeding 1 MB in size,

Label the image as follows:

Last Name: 2 digit number to match entry form, title of work eg. SMITH01Summer.jpg

The submitted images have to be clear and presented at a high enough resolution to be judged. Jurors look for:

- Technical skills, competent & or interesting use of medium & materials
- Originality or uniqueness in presenting the subject
- Has impact that evokes a reaction from the viewer
- Effective use of interest area or defined focal point
- Use of colour & form and how these relate to the composition



2. Pay Fees:

\$15 for the first image + \$5 for ea. additional image. Max of 3.

Open to Arts Council members. You can join by including a Membership fee of \$45.20

3. Prepare and Send the DIGITAL Entry e-mail:

a. Attach the labeled digital files
b. Attach the completed entry form as a Word or pdf document.

c. Title e-mail: Last Name; Brush in Hand. Entry (eg. SMITH; Brush in Hand. Entry)

d. In the body of the e-mail state your surname, first name, cell & home phone numbers.

For each entry list: image number, title of work, measurements, date & sale price followed by NFS if not for sale. Note if you are applying as an **emerging artist**.

Judging

- Entries will be judged by jpg images
- Photographs, slides or printed images will not be judged
- Please see 'Guidelines'

Eligibility

- The competition is open to all ACHH members. **You may join with your entry form.**
- This competition is open to painters only, with a max. of three works per artist.
- Paintings previously exhibited at shows in Haliburton County are not eligible
- Work must have been completed after 2013
- 2 spaces will be specifically designated for emerging artists-painting 5 years or less

Presentation and Qualification

- All work must be original, executed without the supervision of an instructor. Entries must not be copies.
- All accepted works must be ready to hang with wire attached tightly at 3" from top.
- Each work must have 'label information' attached to the back stating the artist's name, address, title of work, medium, size & price

Art Limitations

Due to available space, paintings must not exceed 3 feet wide and 20 pounds.

Sales

A commission of 20% will be paid to the Arts Council. Works which are not for sale must be marked NFS on the entry form.

Transportation and Insurance

Delivery and pick up of the artwork is the sole responsibility of the artist, who must adhere to the dates listed. There is no storage available.

Exhibiting artists are responsible for insuring their own work.

Acceptances

Acceptances will be sent by e-mail. **NO RESULTS WILL BE GIVEN BY PHONE.** Work selected for the exhibition must be as submitted for jurying, or it will be disqualified.

Please Note

No entry may be removed from the exhibition until final pick-up date. Each artist will be asked to sit in the gallery for a few hours, if possible, during the course of the exhibition.

Other Terms & Conditions

The decision of the Jurors is final. By submitting to this exhibition you agree to allow reproduction of your digital files for educational, publicity or archival purposes unless we are informed otherwise in writing.

You agree to waive any exhibition fee.
