Children's Ministry

We love children! Our top priorities are nurturing and teaching children in God's Word while keeping them safe. All teachers and volunteers have been background checked, and we have two teachers in the nursery and in the classrooms when possible. When there is only one teacher in the room, the door remains open and a volunteer is in the hall.
