




If you change your mind, you can opt-in or out again by clicking the small tab at the top of the Add/Edit Questions screen.

New Rubric Creation Opt-in


Instructors can opt-in to the new Rubric creation experience. **The new experience will become the default in November 2020.**

When you click New Rubric in the Rubrics tool, you can choose to opt in or out of the new Rubric creation experience.




As with Quiz Builder, you can opt-in or out again by clicking the small tab at the top of the New Rubric or Edit Rubric screen.
