

**Fairview United Methodist Church**  
**Covid-19 Worship Policy**  
**Updated March 2022**

The CDC currently rates counties in the United States with a Covid-19 Community Level—green for low, yellow for medium, and red for high. The ratings come with recommended prevention steps as follows:

**Low (Green)**

Stay up to date with  
COVID-19 vaccines  
Get tested if you have  
symptoms

**Medium (Yellow)**

If you are at high risk for  
severe illness, talk to your  
healthcare provider about  
whether you need to wear a  
mask and take other  
precautions  
Stay up to date with  
COVID-19 vaccines  
Get tested if you have  
symptoms

**Red (High)**

Wear a mask indoors in  
public  
Stay up to date with  
COVID-19 vaccines  
Get tested if you have  
symptoms  
Additional precautions may  
be needed for people at  
high risk for severe illness

When Boone County is rated at a level Green (Low) or Yellow (Medium), mask wearing at Fairview will be left to the discretion of individuals. When Boone County is rated at level Red (High), we ask that during worship services and church sponsored indoor large group gatherings masks be worn by all, regardless of vaccination status.

The Boone County level will be included in Friday emails to the Fairview Community so folks can plan accordingly. We will continue to have masks and hand sanitizer available at the door.

Because of the ever-changing situation with the Covid-19 pandemic, including the spread of variants, this policy will be reassessed as needed.
