

2019 Year End Report

Eleven delivery trips were made to Mission Central (Mechanicsburg) this year for:

837 cleaning buckets

1706 hygiene kits

1661 school kits

6 ½ gaylord boxes computer equipment

Uncounted miscellaneous personal medical equipment

The HUB, in response to local needs, assembled 227 hygiene kits using UMCOR guidelines with the addition of 4 items: toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, and socks. They were packed in two-gallon bags and distributed to the unsheltered community members by various individuals and organizations to seven counties - Orange, Fauquier, Greene, Louisa, Culpeper, Rappahannock, and Madison.

The HUB participated in 23 events:

8 Harrisonburg District packing events

3 fund-raising dinners

2 flea market fund-raisers

5 regular HUB packing events

The Harrisonburg District funded their packing events (1600 school kits). We attended to organize, lead, educate, and transport kits. Some of those kits will be delivered to Mission Central in January, 2020.

The CVMHUB spent \$22, 500 this year.

We had the honor of working with a boy scout this year who helped the HUB for his Eagle Scout project. He regularly mowed and repaired our storage trailers. He also raised money and organized a school packing

event using local cub scouts and delivered the kits to Mission Central. He earned his Eagle Scout rank in November.
