WELCOME TODAY'S PREACHER: REV. SUZANNE WAGNER

We welcome into the pulpit this morning the Reverend Suzanne E. Wagner, who joined First Church Milford as a member in 2018. Rev. Wagner was ordained into Christian Ministry in the United Church of Christ in 2002 after earning her Master of Divinity degree from Andover Newton Theological School in Newton Center, MA and earlier, her Bachelor of Fine Arts from William Woods University in Fulton, MO.
