The 31st Coffeyville Regional Medical Center Foundation Bill Read Golf Classic will be played on Saturday, September 27 at the Coffeyville Country Club. All proceeds from this event benefit the CRMC Foundation.

The Bill Read Golf Classic celebrates and remembers Dr. William Read. Dr. Read practiced in Coffeyville for more than 40 years following a tour of duty in the Pacific in World War II. Read practiced in Coffeyville until closing his practice in 1987. He delivered about 3,000 babies during that time and served CRMC in a variety of capacities including serving as a trustee from 1972-1987. Read was known for his patience, and his genuine desire to help the people of the community.
