With proper patient selection, IUDs are safe, cost-effective, and easily inserted. Studies show they prevent conception, which makes them more acceptable to patient and physician alike. Reviews indicate they are often inappropriately overlooked as a contraceptive choice. The Mirena is indicated to treat hypermenorrhea. IUDs are approved for 5-10 years of continual use. Experts feel they are underused. This session will review indications, techniques, and practice on models.
