Thursday, April 9: a **FULL BREAKFAST** is included each morning of your stay at the Cornell Club.

Today **Dr. SUE PINGLETON** will take us to the **Metropolitan Museum of Art** where as a guest lecturer, she will guide us through several selected works of art deepening our understanding of these classic originals. There will be time afterward to explore on your own.

High on the bank of the Hudson River you will have sweeping views of the valley and George Washington Bridge as you stroll the gardens. **Sue Pingleton & Ken Walker** will provide special insights.



Tonight is JAZZ NIGHT in New York City. You will have tickets to the 8:00 PM set at **BIRDLAND**, one of the last of the old-time Jazz clubs.

Saturday, April 11: today is left free for you to enjoy New York in your own way; museums, shopping, a favorite restaurant, Central Park or the Highline, or take water tour of New York.

As an option this morning, George Harter will offer a **BOB DYLAN** themed walking tour of **Greenwich Village**. See where Robert Zimmerman first worked and performed in the Village; his first apartment shared with Susie Rotelo on *Positively 4th Street*; spots where Joan Baez introduced him to folk crowds. We will travel by SUBWAY.

Our final dinner party will be at **CAFE UN DEUX TROIS**, in the Theater District, the favorite of many Broadway stars. Cocktail & wines with dinner included.

For your Saturday night on Broadway, we step into the heart of Cuba with **BUENA VISTA SOCIAL CLUB**.



Cathedral of Saint John the Divine


